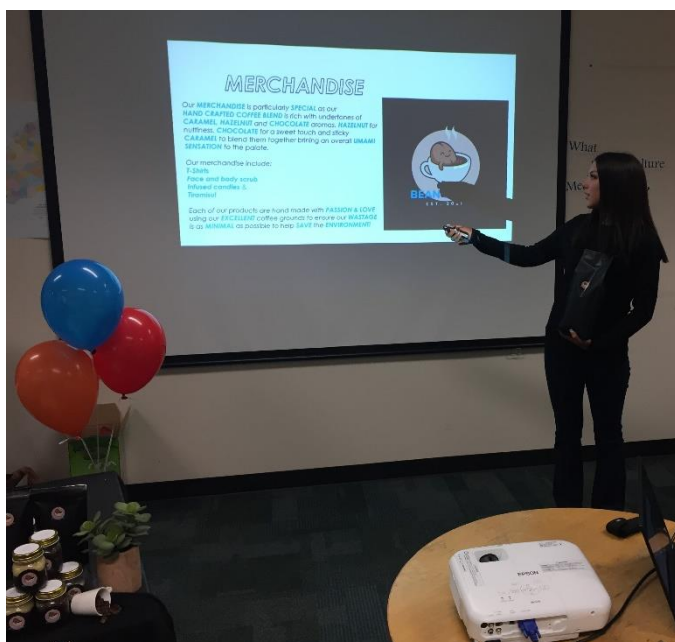
## Cert III Business Short Course



This term students flexed their entrepreneurial muscles while undertaking a Certificate III in Business short course. Students based their learning around setting up a coffee business that supplies a multitude of coffee based products including roasted beans, face scrubs, coffee scented candles and lip balms. Students also had to come up with and agree upon a business name, logo, and a mission statement to be clear about what they were trying to achieve.

To support their business venture, students attended an excursion to a coffee roaster and wholesale outlet. Learning about coffee origins and where beans are imported from, students observed the roasting process and the methods for choosing a blend.

Students then participated in the 'cupping' process to taste and choose between different blends of coffee ranging in flavour and strength. Once a particular blend was agreed upon students pitched their coffee venture to CLC staff looking to secure 'investors' in their new business.

We started the event celebrating the achievements that students have made this year including SACE completion and outstanding achievement awards.
